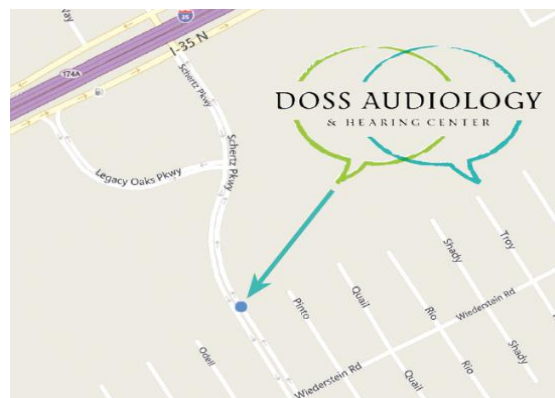

Recipe Corner >>>

Easy Apple Pie Bites



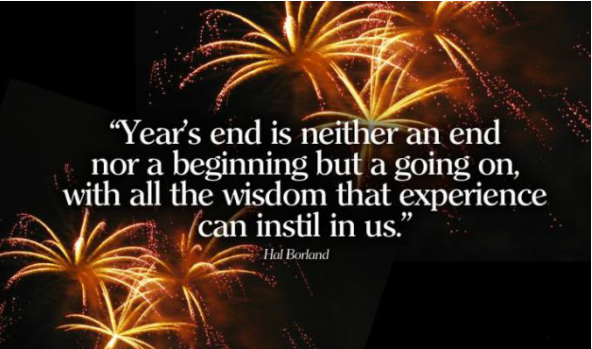
Ingredients:

- 1/3 cup brown sugar
 - 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
 - 3 tablespoons butter, melted
 - 1/3 Granny Smith apple, cored and sliced into 8 (1/2-inch) slices
 - 1 (8 ounce) can Pillsbury Original crescent rolls
 - Crushed pecans or walnuts
- Heat oven to 375 degrees. Line cookie sheet with parchment paper. Set aside.
 - Unwrap the crescent roll and separate the triangles.
 - Combine sugar and cinnamon in a small bowl.
 - Evenly spread butter onto each crescent triangle.
 - Sprinkle each triangle with the sugar and cinnamon mixture, as well as the crushed nuts
 - Place a slice of apple on the wider side of each triangle, and roll dough into a croissant
 - Arrange apple bites on a cookie sheet
 - Spread the remaining butter on each bite and sprinkle more of the sugar and cinnamon mixture on them
 - Bake for 12-15 minutes until golden
 - Remove from oven and cool for 10 minutes before serving
